Updated deployment package with Keystone Lake / Atwood Access as location 9

Live Map Overview

This updated package keeps the Shelocta-centered list with Keystone Lake / Atwood Access as location 9. The HTML package now uses an embedded live Google Maps route instead of a static map image; the source CSV and HTML card numbering match.

Strongest Shortlist

Blue Spruce Park - strongest public park/water/group option.
Thomas Covered Bridge - closest distinctive historic bridge.
Fairman Family Farms - strongest true-Shelocta rustic venue.
Crooked Creek Lake - biggest water and sunset-scale landscape.
Keystone Lake / Atwood Access - closest true reservoir scouting option.

1. Fairman Family Farms

about 2-3 mi | about 6-8 min

Photographic strengths

Barn siding, open lawn, gravel approaches, farm edges, and soft country backgrounds.

Best use

Bride and groom portraits, bridal portraits, bridesmaids, fall wedding-party details.

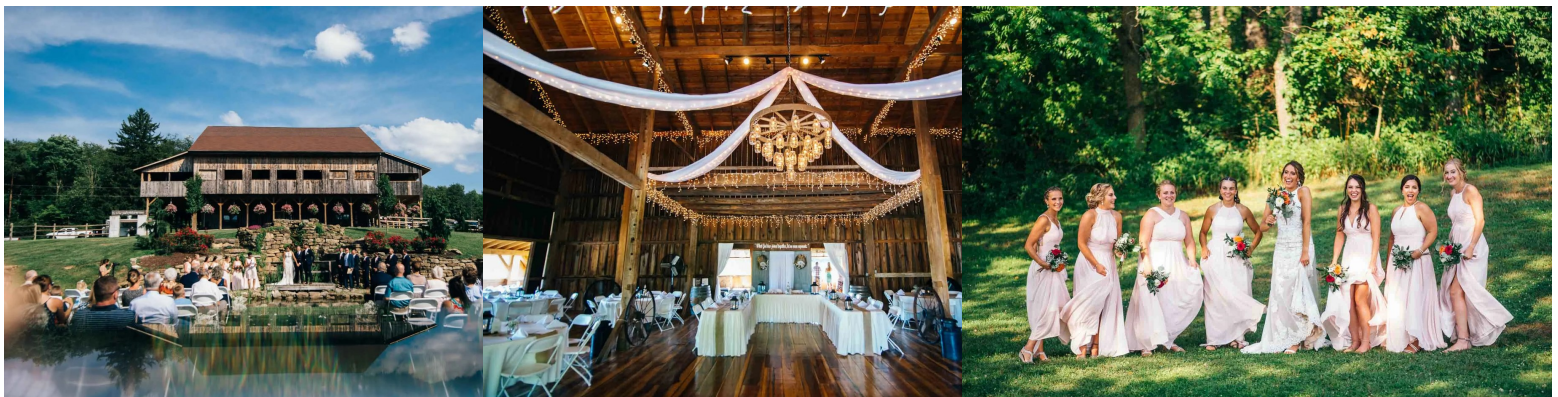
Best visible angles / areas

Use the barn face and lawn edges for clean formal portraits; place couples on the gravel lane or field edge for depth; use the wider grounds for small wedding-party groupings.

Late-August / September look

Late August and September should read warm and agricultural, with green-to-gold fields and early fall texture around the venue grounds.

2. Wheel-In Campground

about 4 mi | about 8-10 min

Maps name: Wheel-In Campground | Address: 113 Wheelin Camp Ground / Plumcreek Rd, Shelocta, PA 15774 | Coordinates: 40.679657, -79.333934

Photographic strengths

Tree canopy, water-adjacent campground roads, open grassy areas, and rural wooded edges.

Best use

Couple portraits, groomsmen, casual bridesmaids, small wedding-party sets.

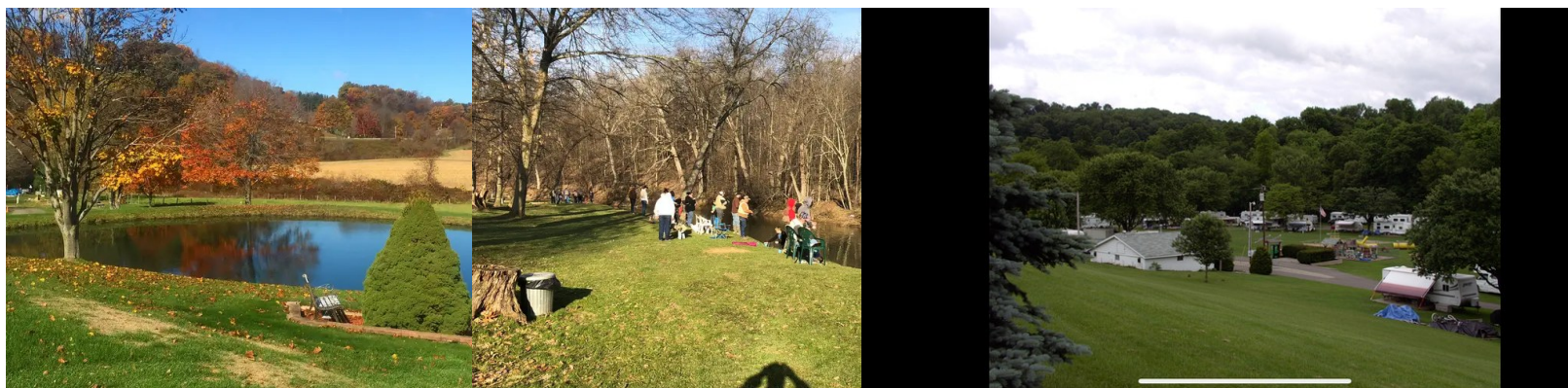
Best visible angles / areas

Frame subjects along the treeline and creek-adjacent clearings; use the open lawns for looser groups and the road curves for leading lines.

Late-August / September look

Expect green late-summer grass, shaded woods, and the first muted fall tones by late September.

3. Thomas Covered Bridge

about 5-6 mi | about 10-12 min

Maps name: Thomas Covered Bridge | Address: 280 Thomas Covered Bridge Rd, Indiana, PA 15701 | Coordinates: 40.664409, -79.236871

Photographic strengths

Historic covered bridge, deep red timber, creek setting, truss interior, and wooded road edges.

Best use

Bride and groom portraits, bridal portraits, groomsmen, smaller wedding-party groupings.

Best visible angles / areas

Shoot straight-on at the bridge portal, inside the trusses for graphic framing, and from the creek side for bridge-plus-water compositions.

Late-August / September look

In September, the red bridge should contrast strongly with green trees, late-summer creek banks, and early autumn color.

4. Trusal Covered Bridge

about 12-14 mi | about 20-24 min

Maps name: Trusal Covered Bridge | Address: 1961 Trusal Rd, Creekside, PA 15732 | Coordinates: 40.730350, -79.184290

Photographic strengths

Small covered bridge, creek corridor, wooded banks, and simple rural road context.

Best use

Bride and groom portraits, groomsmen, intimate wedding-party photographs.

Best visible angles / areas

Use downstream views for environmental portraits, bridge portals for symmetry, and side views for a stronger sense of place.

Late-August / September look

Late August should be lush; September adds warmer creekside color and a rustic fall character.

5. Harmon Covered Bridge

about 13-15 mi | about 22-26 min

Maps name: Harmon Covered Bridge | Address: 2725 Donahue Rd, Creekside, PA 15732 | Coordinates: 40.734030, -79.175530

Photographic strengths

Covered bridge structure, red timber, country-road approach, creekside greenery, and layered side elevations.

Best use

Bride and groom portraits, bridal portraits, groomsmen, small wedding-party sets.

Best visible angles / areas

Use side elevations for full bridge context, the portal for centered portraits, and the road approach for walking images.

Late-August / September look

The bridge should hold strong color against late-summer foliage, with better fall warmth toward late September.

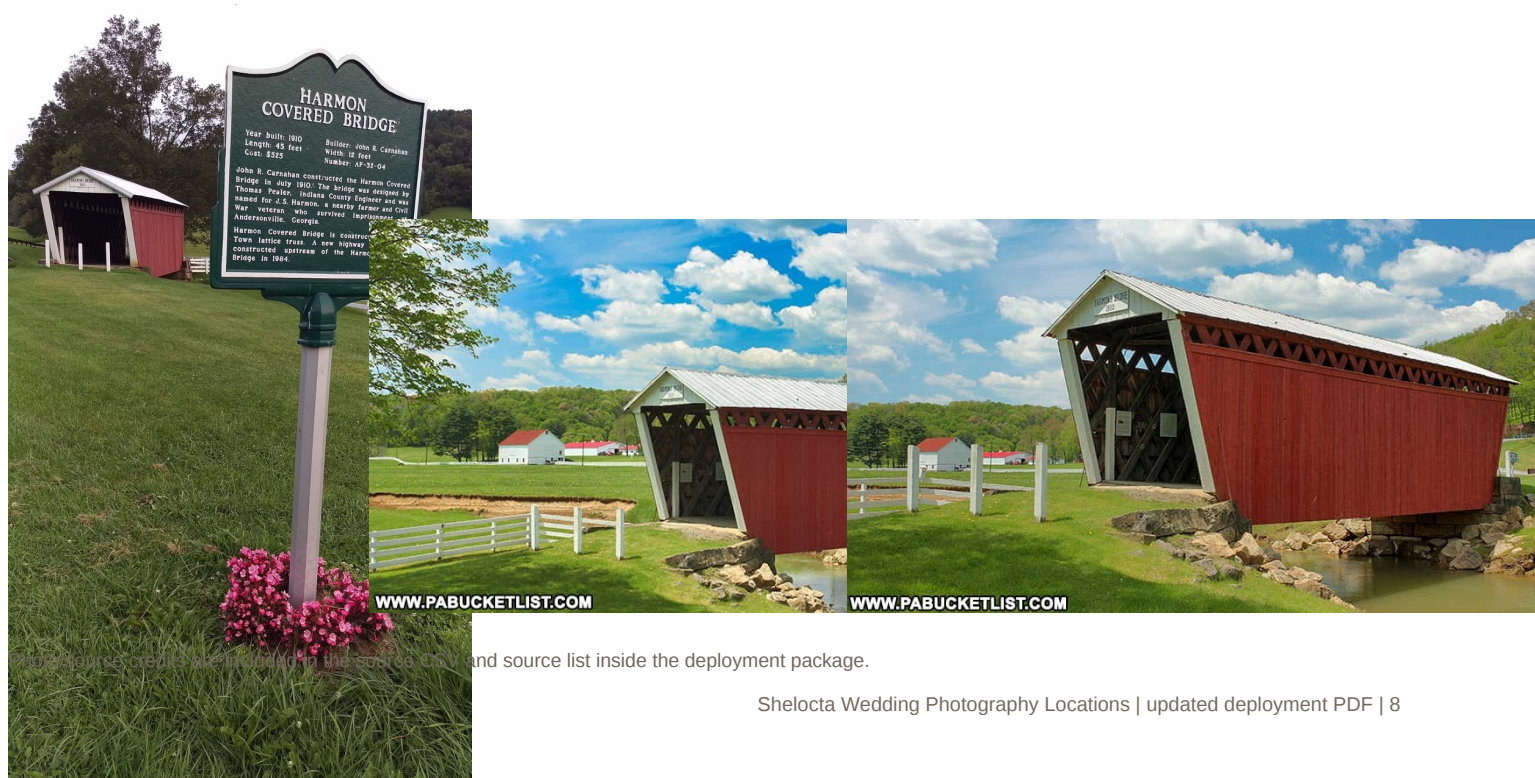

6. Silver Canoe Campground

about 12-14 mi | about 20-24 min

Maps name: Silver Canoe Campground | Address: 140 Silver Canoe Campground Ln, Rural Valley, PA 16249 | Coordinates: 40.770875, -79.240426

Photographic strengths

Riverfront and creek-adjacent areas, cabins, open lawns, gravel lanes, and wooded camp edges.

Best use

Couple portraits, bridesmaids, groomsmen, casual full-party photographs.

Best visible angles / areas

Work along the water edge and cabin lines for rustic depth; use the open lawn areas for larger groups.

Late-August / September look

September should bring saturated greens, early golden edges, and warm outdoor-camp textures.

7. Blue Spruce Park

about 12-14 mi | about 20-24 min

Maps name: Blue Spruce Park | Address: 1128 Blue Spruce Rd, Indiana, PA 15701 | Coordinates: 40.691760, -79.159620

Photographic strengths

Lake views, mature trees, open lawns, paths, boardwalk-like edges, and broad public-park space.

Best use

Full wedding party, bride and groom, bridesmaids, bridal shower portraits, fall-themed photographs.

Best visible angles / areas

Use the lake as a clean horizon, paths for walking portraits, and mature tree clusters for shaded groups.

Late-August / September look

One of the strongest September choices: water, greenery, and reliable early fall color in one stop.

8. Crooked Creek Lake

about 14-16 mi | about 24-30 min

Maps name: Crooked Creek Lake | Address: 114 Park Main Rd, Ford City, PA 16226 | Coordinates: 40.714231, -79.508100

Photographic strengths

Expansive water, open sky, wooded shorelines, recreation roads, and broad scenic scale.

Best use

Bride and groom portraits, full wedding party, groomsmen, fall sunset portraits.

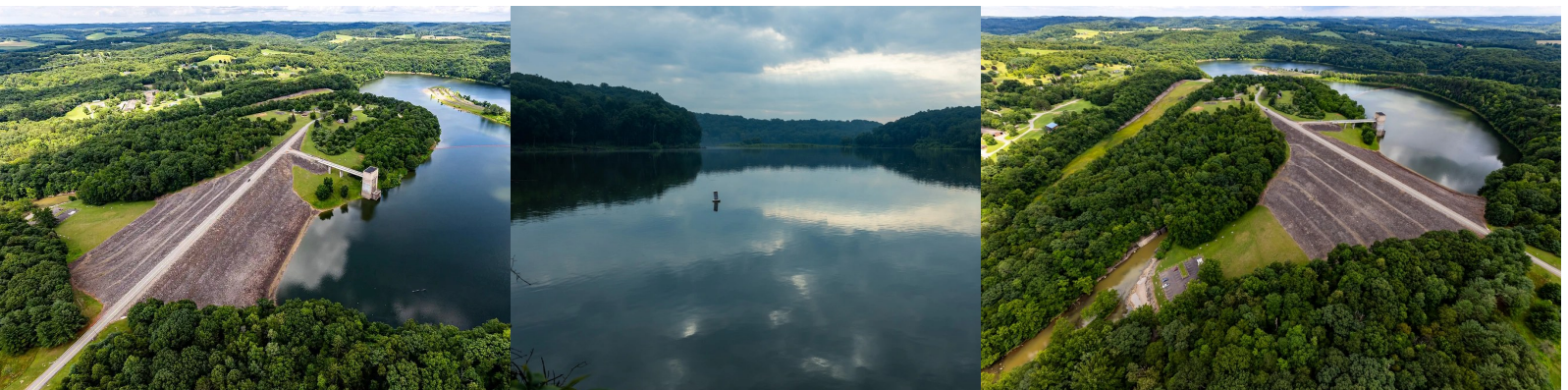
Best visible angles / areas

Use lake edges for horizon-line portraits, wooded shorelines for depth, and open sky for late-day silhouettes.

Late-August / September look

Late August and September should offer broad green-to-gold shorelines and stronger sunset atmosphere than tighter sites.

9. Keystone Lake / Atwood Access

about 11-13 mi | about 18-22 min

Maps name: Atwood Boat Ramp / Keystone Lake | Address: Atwood Boat Ramp, Plumcreek Township, PA near Rural Valley | Coordinates: 40.757732, -79.283484

Photographic strengths

Keystone Lake water access, boat-ramp approach, wooded shoreline, open sky, and calm reservoir coves.

Best use

Couple portraits, groomsman, fall lake scouting, smaller wedding-party sets.

Best visible angles / areas

Scout Atwood first for waterline views and road-access practicality; also review nearby NuMine, Fisher Farm Road, and Reefer's Cove access points for cleaner shoreline angles.

Late-August / September look

Late August and September should offer green banks, warm late-day water reflections, and early fall color around the lake edges.

10. Whites' Woods Nature Center

about 13-15 mi | about 22-28 min

Maps name: Whites' Woods Nature Center | Address: 200 Forest Ridge Rd, Indiana, PA 15701 | Coordinates: 40.633480, -79.169190

Photographic strengths

Forest trails, tall trees, meadow openings, dappled light, and quiet nature-center edges.

Best use

Bride and groom portraits, bridal portraits, fall-themed portraits, intimate wedding-party sets.

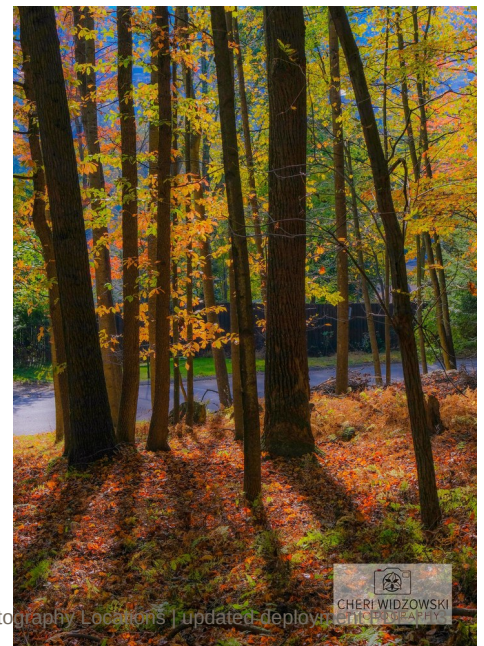
Best visible angles / areas

Use trail curves for depth, meadow edges for soft backlight, and vertical tree trunks for simple natural framing.

Late-August / September look

Late August is lush and shaded; September should start showing golden understory and early woodland color.
